Canvas is the learning management system Edmond Public Schools is using at the secondary level. A learning management system, or LMS, is a software-based platform that provides a framework and tools to facilitate online learning both inside and outside the school building. The students can access classroom resources, communicate with teachers, submit assignments, and take online assessments. Canvas was chosen as the LMS for our school district because of its wide range of easy to use tools for teachers, students, and parents. With an Observer account, you can see course information, assignments, and events for your student. **To access your student's grades**, you will still use the **Infinite Campus Parent Portal**. There are 2 different ways to create an Observer Account:

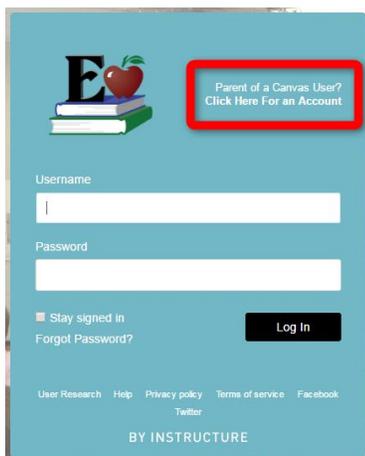
- through the Edmond Canvas website
and/or
- through the Canvas Parent app (for Android or iOS devices)

Note: You will need an email address and your student's Canvas username and password in order to create an account.

To Create Your Parent Account on the Edmond Canvas Website:

1. Navigate to the website: <https://edmondschools.instructure.com>

Note: Google Chrome is the preferred web browser for Canvas. It can be accessed in other browsers, but for best results, please use Google Chrome.



2. Click the “Parent of a Canvas User? Click Here For an Account” link in the upper right corner. (See image.)

3. Type in your name, email address, and your student's Canvas username and password.

4. Read the terms of use and privacy policy.

5. Check the box to agree to the terms of use and privacy policy.

6. Click the “Start Participating” button.

7. Navigate to your email and look for an email from Canvas.

8. **Open** the **email** from Canvas.

9. **Click** on the **link provided in the email** to complete the registration process.

***Please note your username (email address) and remember your password.**

10. Finish the registration process by **typing** in a **password** for your Canvas access.

11. Make sure your “Time Zone” is correct. If not, select the “arrow” to choose the correct time zone.

12. **Click** “Register.”

13. Once you are logged into Canvas, you will see the “User Dashboard.” You can access your student’s calendar by clicking on “Calendar” on the left menu. Shown on the Dashboard are the courses your student is enrolled in. When your student’s teacher has published a course, you will be able to click on it to access the course.

14. Lastly, as an Observer you will want to set up your Notification Preferences (how you want to be notified of things happening in Canvas). Please follow the following link to the guide that will help you with this process: <http://tinyurl.com/NotificationsInCanvas>
